A. Adopt the Laguna County Sanitation District Sewer Design Specifications and Development Standards.

Executive Summary and Discussion:

Sewer design and development standards address issues related to private development projects by setting minimum design standards. The standards are primarily associated with new sewer systems that are to be dedicated to the District. It also describes the review and approval process and District policies.

The Laguna County Sanitation District has been operating under design specifications from its inception in 1959. The new specifications and standards will update the old standards.
