- September – LPC reviewed and commented on updated principles and planks
- October – LPC received initial draft of the 2020 Legislative Platform

Today's Purpose

- Review, discuss and recommend additional changes to the Draft 2020 Legislative Platform
- Legislative Program Committee will review the 2020 Platform for inclusion of recommended changes at their committee meeting on December 9th

Overview of the Draft 2020 Legislative Platform

- No revisions to the principles
- 44 Platform Planks – mostly small updates and language changes
 - One recommended for deletion – New ag pests

Final Approval of the 2020 Platform

- Return on December 17, 2019
- Final Draft 2020 Legislative Platform will include all recommended changes provided today and year-end summary
- Report from the County's advocates on this past year
- Consider a resolution to make changes to the Legislative Program Committee

Recommended Actions for Today

- Receive an update on issues and projects included as part of the County's Draft 2020 Legislative Platform; and
- Provide staff with direction about any recommended changes to the County's Draft 2020 Legislative Platform; and
- Find that the proposed actions do not constitute a "Project" within the meaning of California Environmental Quality Act, pursuant to 14 CCR 15378(b)(2), as it consists of general policy and procedure making.
