Recommended Actions: Authorize the Chair of the Board to:

- (a) Approve the attached "Notice of Exemption" pursuant to California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) guidelines regarding the acceptance of an easement for the operation and maintenance of a sidewalk on a portion of 775 East Clark Avenue in Orcutt; and
- (b) Accept a permanent Easement Deed from Mr. and Mrs. LeBard, owners of 775 East Clark Avenue (APN 105-020-041) by authorizing the Clerk of the Board to sign the Certificate of Acceptance attached to the Permanent Easement deed regarding the above referenced sidewalk.

Summary Text:

Mr. and Mrs. LeBard as the owners of 775 East Clark Avenue have received approval to construct a commercial building on that property. The new construction includes a pedestrian sidewalk along a portion of East Clark in front of the building. The LeBards have offered to dedicate that sidewalk to the County by way of an Easement Deed. If accepted by the Board of Supervisors and recorded the easement will memorialize the transfer of rights and will grant the County the right to maintain the sidewalk.

Background:

Mr. and Mrs. LeBard received final approval of their building plans in late August 2007. Construction is scheduled to commence soon. The LeBards agreed to pay for the County staff time required to transfer the easement to the County. Transportation has approved the acceptance of the sidewalk easement.

On September 17, 2007, the Planning Commission found the acceptance of the Easement to be in compliance with the County's Comprehensive Plan in accordance with Government Code Section 65402(a).
