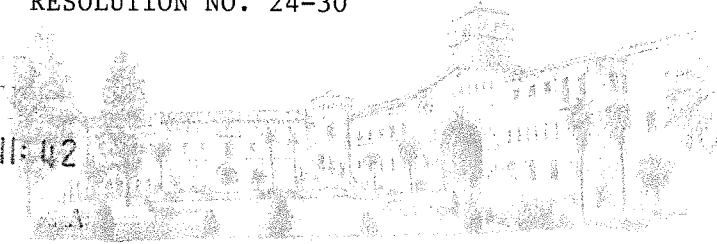

# COUNTY OF SANTA BARBARA CALIFORNIA

**RESOLUTION PROCLAIMING  
MARCH 10<sup>th</sup> TIBET DAY IN  
SANTA BARBARA COUNTY**

*WHEREAS, sixty-five years ago, Tibetans took a stand, together, for the freedom of their homeland. The people of the Tibetan capital, Lhasa, fearing for the life of the Dalai Lama, surrounded his residence, organized a guard, and called for the withdrawal of Chinese forces from Tibet and the restoration of Tibet's freedom; and*

*WHEREAS, Chinese statistics estimate 87,000 Tibetans were killed, arrested, or deported to labor camps during the suppression of the 1959 uprising, which also led to the forced exile of the Dalai Lama and tens of thousands of other Tibetans; and*

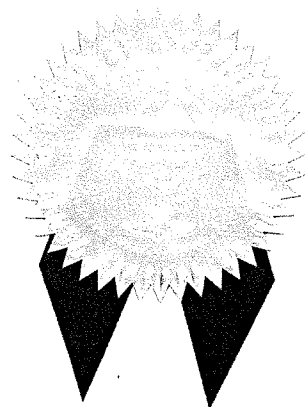
*WHEREAS, today, sixty-five years later, the Government of the People's Republic of China remains engaged in the severe repression of Tibet's unique religious, cultural, and linguistic heritage, and is engaged in gross violations of human rights in Tibet, including extrajudicial detentions, disappearances, and torture; and*

*WHEREAS, the Tibetan people have not given up their struggle for fundamental human rights and freedoms. Tibetans today are still striving to gain their freedoms back to practice and preserve their national identity as they remain under China's communist rule; and*

*WHEREAS, Santa Barbara Friends of Tibet and Santa Barbara Summit for Tibet are two of many international groups working together for this same goal. We stand by the Tibetan people, who have long been our unwavering friends. By displaying the Tibetan flag one day a year that symbolizes our support of human rights in China and world-wide;*

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT AND IT IS HEREBY ORDERED AND RESOLVED** that this Board of Supervisors declares March 10<sup>th</sup>, 2024 as Tibet Day in Santa Barbara County and authorizes the Department of General Services to fly the Tibetan Flag on March 7<sup>th</sup> - 10<sup>th</sup>, 2024 at the Santa Barbara County Administration Building.

**PASSED AND ADOPTED** by the Board of Supervisors of Santa Barbara County, State of California, this 5<sup>th</sup> day of March, 2024 by the unanimous vote of all members present.
