Recommended Actions:

That the Board of Supervisors authorize the Chair to execute the attached CREF contract (BC-11-048) with the Santa Maria Natural History Museum, for the period of October 12, 2010 to March 20, 2016, in the amount of \$12,309, to purchase and install a shore bird exhibit at its Natural History Museum, located at 412 S. McClelland Avenue in Santa Maria, located in the Fifth Supervisorial District.

<u>Summary Text:</u> The Santa Maria Natural History Museum would use the \$12,309 CREF grant towards purchase, transportation and installation of 30 existing taxidermy shore birds from the High Desert Natural History Museum in Twenty-Nine Palms. In addition, the Museum would purchase existing background exhibit art work, a cabinet, a case, a television, and stools. Lastly, the Museum would operate the exhibit for a period of not less than five years.

<u>Background:</u> Mitigation of impacts to coastal resources from offshore oil and gas development is required as a condition of permits on three projects. Mitigation is provided through the Coastal Resource Enhancement Fund. In the 2010 CREF funding cycle, the Board of Supervisors allocated \$12,309 to the Santa Maria Natural History Museum towards the shore bird exhibit. This contract executes this grant. There are no changes in service level as a result of this contract.

Fiscal and Facilities Impacts:

No fiscal and facilities impacts. The Coastal Resource Enhancement Fund is funded by annual mitigation fees paid by developers of offshore oil and gas reserves. Fees to fund a grant were received in FY 09-10 and are included in the County's FY 10/11 Budget on page D-342 "Source of Funds Summary – Use of Prior Fund Balances." Staff costs to prepare this contract have been offset by interest accrued to the Coastal Resource Enhancement Fund. The \$12,309 for the shore bird exhibit are expended from Fund #0063, Dept. #053, Program #5090, Account #7863, Project #1008.
