RECOMMENDATIONS:

That the Board of Supervisors:

- A. Set a public hearing for **April 6, 2004** to consider introduction of an ordinance amending Section 23-11.1 of the Santa Barbara County Code. The amendment is to add "Green" along with its meaning to the list of curb marking colors.
- B. Conduct a second hearing on **April 13, 2004** and adopt the attached ordinance, amending Section 23-11.1 of the Santa Barbara County Code.

ALIGNMENT WITH BOARD STRATEGIC PLAN:

The recommendation is primarily aligned with the following Goals: #2) Ensure the Public Health and Safety and Provide Essential Infrastructure, and #5) Maintain and Enhance the Quality of Life for all Residents.

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY & DISCUSSION:

The Public Works Department requests that your Board establish green curb parking zones as 15, 20, or 30 minutes, as delineated, between 7:00 A.M. and 6:00 P.M. on any day except Sundays and holidays. At this time there are no existing ordinances allowing green curb markings in the Santa Barbara County Code. This action will allow future green zones to be designated as needed which will allow the Department to be more responsive to the needs of the communities we serve.

This item is not expected to result in any mandates or service level changes.
