



## Requested Redesign


- The Board Requested:
  - Remove the four westernmost proposed residences.
  - Develop a pocket park which is accessible to the public.
  - Add visitor parking spaces.
  - Resolve shared driveway parking conflicts.




## Proposed Redesign

- Project redesigned as follows:
  - Four units and corresponding lots have been removed.
  - A 21,990 square foot passive recreation area has been added.
  - Three visitor parking spaces have been added.
  - Each shared driveway has been widened by 2-feet allowing two cars to be parked in each unit's driveway.



## Effects of Redesign

All aspects of grading (cut, fill, and import) have been reduced.

Project density for the Planned Unit Development is now 4.7 units per acre.



#### Site Statistics

- Building Area- 19,244 s.f. (18.8%)
- Parking and Driveways- 8,429 s.f. (8.2%)
- Public Recreation Area- 21,990 s.f. (21.5%)
- Other Landscaped Area- 52,702 s.f. (51.5%)
