FY 2022-23 CDBG funds are estimated based on the Department of Housing and Urban Development’s FY 2021-22 allocation to the County. The Allocations Committee provided additional direction to HCD staff on final distribution amounts in the event that the final FY 2022-23 CDBG allocation was greater or less than the prior year’s allocated amount. If the actual FY 2022-23 CDBG Public Services funding amount from HUD exceeds the estimate by \$15,000 or more, additional funds will be recommended for WillBridge of Santa Barbara (but not to exceed the amount requested). If the actual funding amount exceeds the estimate by less than \$15,000, additional funds will be divided equally between PSHHC’s Homelessness Prevention program and PATH. If the actual funding amount is lower than estimated, funds will be deducted equally from Domestic Violence Solutions and PATH.
