Project Description: The United States Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) provides homeless assistance funding through the Continuum of Care (CoC) Program; HUD requires communities to implement HMIS, a locally-managed information technology system that collects client-level data and data on the provision of housing and services to individuals and families who are homeless or at risk of homelessness, as a condition of receiving funds through the CoC Program. HMIS provides information for policy makers and homeless service providers on the extent and nature of homelessness.
