WHEREAS, California Vehicle Code Sections 21354, 22503 and 22507 and the Code of Santa Barbara County, California, Sections 23-1 and 23-11, authorize the Board of Supervisors of the County, to establish stop intersections, or parking regulations on portions of roads and highways under its jurisdiction; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of public safety that certain portions of County highways in Santa Barbara County be designated as stop intersections or no stopping, standing, or parking zones, in accordance with said Sections;

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED AND ORDERED, that the following locations in Santa Barbara County and under the jurisdiction of the Board of Supervisors of said County are hereby designated as stop intersections, angle parking zones, handicapped parking zones or no stopping, standing, or parking zones and that the Director of Public Works of the County of Santa Barbara is hereby authorized and directed to install and maintain appropriate pavement markings and signs at the following locations.

Stop Control

Stopping all traffic entering the intersection of Santa Rosa Lane and Sinaloa Drive.

No Stopping, Standing, or Parking Zone

- On both sides of Cravens Lane from State Route 192 to the City of Carpinteria limits.
- On the north side of Cathedral Oaks Road from the centerline of San Marcos Road (East) to a point 375 feet east of the centerline of Ribera Drive.
- On the south side of Cathedral Oaks Road from the centerline of Vala Drive to a point 840 feet west of the centerline of Ribera Drive.
- On the north side of Alamo Pintado Avenue between the centerline of Grand Avenue and a point 56 feet west of the centerline of Grand Avenue.
- On the north side of Union Avenue between a point 108 feet west of the centerline of First Street and a point 155 feet west of the centerline of First Street.

Angle Parking Zone

• On the north side of Alamo Pintado Avenue between a point 56 feet west of the centerline of Grand Avenue and a point 227 feet west of the centerline of Grand Avenue
