

RESOLUTION OF COMMENDATION FOR FREDERICK C. LAMONT FOR HIS 13 YEARS OF DEDICATED SERVICE

WHEREAS, Frederick C. Lamont has retired from the Housing Authority of the County of Santa Barbara after 13 years as the Executive Director; and

WHEREAS, his leadership played a key role in determining the character, quality, and success of the agency's housing programs and related services for low and moderate income households; and

WHEREAS, with Frederick's persistence and innovation, the Housing Authority has embarked on creative projects, such as the installation of solar panels in 21 sites, and has received numerous awards for program innovation, project design, and overcoming significant obstacles; and

WHEREAS, during Frederick's tenure, the Housing Authority provided 565 affordable housing units and continually produced and maintained high quality housing for low income families and individuals in a financially responsible manner; and

WHEREAS, Frederick is highly respected by his colleagues and has been instrumental in leveraging community partnerships, which has enabled the Housing Authority to provide affordable, safe and healthy places for local residents to live; and

WHEREAS, Frederick as Executive Director lead the charge to effectively advance the interests of the Housing Authority of the County of Santa Barbara and its program participants, and, in so doing, improved communities in Santa Barbara County and positively influenced the quality of life for many thousands of residents served by the agency; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY ORDERED AND RESOLVED that the Board of Supervisors of Santa Barbara County does hereby commend Frederick C. Lamont for his 13 years of dedicated service to the Housing Authority of the County of Santa Barbara.
