Recommended Actions:

That the Board of Supervisors:

- A. Approve plans and specifications for the 2012 Las Palmas Drive Reconstruction in the Second Supervisorial District of the County of Santa Barbara, County Project No. 862352;
- B. Award the construction contract in the amount of \$302,585.00 to the lowest responsible bidder, Toro Enterprises Incorporated, 2101 East Ventura Boulevard, Oxnard, California 93036; subject to the provision of documents and certifications, as set forth in the plans and specifications applicable to the project, as required under California Law;
- C. Approve and authorize the Chair to execute the construction contract, upon return of the Contractor's executed contract documents, and the review and approval of the County Counsel, Auditor-Controller and Risk Manager or their authorized representatives,
- D. Approve a contingency fund of \$27,629.25 for the 2012 Las Palmas Drive Reconstruction in the Second Supervisorial District of the County of Santa Barbara; County Project No. 862352,
- E. Find that the proposed actions are administrative activities that do not constitute a "Project" within the meaning of CEQA, pursuant to 14 CCR 15378(b)(2), that the proposed actions are therefore exempt from CEQA;
- F. Approve the filing of Notice of Exemption and all further administrative activities, including the Statement of Final Quantities, on that basis.

Summary Text:

On July 5, 2012, Public Works opened six bids for the 2012 Las Palmas Drive Reconstruction in the Second Supervisorial District of the County of Santa Barbara, County Project No. 862352. Toro Enterprises Incorporated submitted the lowest responsible bid in the amount of \$302,585.00, which is 6.8% above the Engineer’s Estimate. The second lowest bid was 10% above the Engineer’s Estimate.

This project was bid in accordance with the Public Contract Code, which requires the award go to the lowest responsible bidder. The Department analyzed the bids and determined that the low bid is responsive and responsible. Public Works recommends that your Board award this contract to Toro Enterprises Incorporated.

This project will reconstruct and resurface approximately one lane mile of Las Palmas Drive in unincorporated area of Hope Ranch. This includes grinding up the existing road and replacing it with new pavement. A subsequent surface treatment project is planned for the roadway at the entrance of Hope Ranch to the limits of this project using General Fund contribution funds. That work is planned as part of a separate, countywide surface treatment project.
