### **RE: Exxon Oil Trucking Plan - OPPOSE**

Dear Mr. Williams, Mr. Hart, Ms. Hartman, Mr. Nelson, and Mr. Lavagnino,

On behalf of the Santa Barbara Women's Political Committee (SBWPC), I am writing to express opposition to EXXON's dangerous plan restart three offshore oil platforms in the Santa Barbara Channel, and then to truck the oil along our coast to refineries. SBWPC's mission is dedicated to furthering feminist values. Our organization is one of the largest women's political committees in Santa Barbara County with hundreds of members. We advocate for a diverse set of positions which include The Environment.

We are aware that ExxonMobil plans to send 70 tanker trucks, carrying more than 460,000 gallons of oil per day, along the winding coastal Highway 101 and the narrow and over-crowded Route 166, for up to seven years. This is completely unacceptable due to spill and other hazards that are certain to happen.

To put it succinctly, **The Santa Barbara Women's Political Committee strongly opposes Exxon's very dangerous trucking plan.**
