Consider Response to the Grand Jury Report on "A Child's Death in Foster Care –

An Unavoidable Tragedy?"

Recommended Actions: That the Board of Supervisors:

a. Adopt the responses in Attachment (1) as the Board of Supervisors' responses to the 2008-09 Grand Jury Report entitled "A Child's Death in Foster Care – An Unavoidable Tragedy?", and

b. Authorize the Chair to sign the letter included in Attachment (1) forwarding the responses to the Presiding Judge.

Summary Text:

On June 11, 2009, the Civil Grand Jury released a report entitled "A Child's Death in Foster Care – An Unavoidable Tragedy?" The report includes four findings and four recommendations. The Department of Social Services is named as the Santa Barbara County government responder to the findings and recommendations.

It is recommended that the Board wholly disagree with part of Finding 1; partially disagree with Finding 2 and 4 and wholly disagree with Finding 3. It is recommended that the Board respond to the recommendations as follows: Recommendations 1, 2, and 4 have been implemented, and Recommendation 3 will not be implemented because it is not warranted or is not reasonable. Details of these proposed responses are outlined in Attachment (1).

Background:

In accordance with California Penal Code Section 933(c), the governing body of the agency (Board of Supervisors) must respond within 90 days after issuance of the Civil Grand Jury report. Consequently,

the Board of Supervisors' responses must be finalized and transmitted to the Presiding Judge of the Superior Court no later than September 8, 2009.
