RESOLUTION PROCLAIMING APRIL 26th through May 2nd CALIFORNIA "CRIME VICTIMS" RIGHTS WEEK"
IN SANTA BARBARA COUNTY

WHEREAS, the lives of children, women, men, extended families and communities continue to be negatively and often severely impacted by crime

WHEREAS, the criminal justice system would fail to function without the cooperation of victims and witnesses; and

WHEREAS, a fair and balanced criminal justice system must ensure that the needs and rights of victims are not overlooked in the process of protecting the rights of the accused; and

WHEREAS, the Santa Barbara County District Attorney's Office through its Victim Witness Assistance Program offers information, support, referrals, and State Victim Compensation Program to victims of crime to mitigate the trauma, and

WHEREAS, victims and witnesses who have suffered loss and trauma deserve fair and sensitive treatment by representatives of the criminal justice system; and

WHEREAS, the observance of Victim's Rights Week provides an opportunity to inform the public of the problems, needs, and rights of victims and witnesses, and of the range of services and assistance available, and to acknowledge the efforts of concerned citizens, law makers and the criminal justice system to provide and continue to improve those services;

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED AND RESOLVED that this Board of Supervisors proclaims April  $26^{th}$  through May  $2^{nd}$  as CRIME VICTIMS' RIGHTS WEEK, and urges all residents to be part of the solution to reducing crime in our County.
