Recommended Actions:

That the Board of Supervisors:

- a) Approve and authorize the Chair to execute, on behalf of the County of Santa Barbara, a First Amendment to the Agreement for Professional Legal Services with Meyers Nave in an amount not-to-exceed \$2,225,000; and
- b) Determine that the above actions are not a project under the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) pursuant to Section 15378(b)(5) of the State CEQA Guidelines, because they consist of administrative activities of government that will not result in direct or indirect physical changes in the environment.

Summary Text:

The County routinely requires legal advice and representation in defending against tort and real property claims and litigation. While the Office of County Counsel regularly provides those legal services, under some circumstances it is necessary or beneficial for the County to retain the services of a qualified private law firm to provide those services. The County is a defendant and cross-complainant in litigation that relates to the January 9, 2023 storm event in the Santa Barbara County Superior Court. County Counsel recommends retaining the law firm Meyers Nave for representation of this litigation because Meyers Nave has the expertise and capacity required to

handle this area of law and the multiple parties involved therein. This First Amendment will authorize Meyers Nave to continue to represent the County in this litigation within the contract's two-year term (ending October 1, 2026) and increase the not-to-exceed amount to \$2,225,000.
