

## COUNTY OF SANTA BARBARA RESOLUTION HONORING SCOTT BULL CALIFORNIA

RESOLUTION HONORING SCOTT BULL UPON BEING SELECTED AS A 2012 ENVI AWARD RECIPIENT

WHEREAS, Scott Bull has been selected by the Environmental Defense Center as a 2012 ENVI award recipient for his dedication to preserving and protecting our natural environment; and

WHEREAS, the ENVI Award, which is an abbreviation for ENVIronment, is meant as a single symbol of appreciation for the many ways in which an individual or organization has contributed to the long term environmental health of our community and our planet; and

WHEREAS, Scott Bull has demonstrated leadership and vision through his actions that have served to enhance protections for the coastal and inland environment of Santa Barbara County. Specifically, his work, participation and involvement with Surfrider and the Coastal Fund has led to increased funding and support for a myriad of programs and efforts including preservation of Naples and the Gaviota Coast, long term protection of Goleta Beach, raising awareness of the local and global impacts from increasing Ocean Acidification, advocating for stronger regulations to protect whales from international shipping, and providing dozens of UCSB internships for the next generation of scientific leaders; and

WHEREAS, while an undergraduate at UCSB, Scott co-founded the Isla Vista Chapter of the Surfrider Foundation in 1994. Then, in 1999, he led a campus-wide ballot initiative that established the Coastal Fund (originally the Shoreline Preservation Fund) where he now serves as the chair of its Board of Directors. The Coastal Fund currently distributes more than \$350,000 annually to local conservation efforts, especially those effecting UCSB and its surroundings.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT AND IT IS HEREBY ORDERED AND RESOLVED that this Board of Supervisors honors Scott Bull upon his receiving the 2012 ENVI award and further commends him for his commitment and dedication to protecting our natural environment for future generations.
