WHEREAS, People Helping People is dedicated to improving the lives of men, women and children in the Santa Ynez Valley, Los Alamos and Gaviota Coast; and

WHEREAS, They have a vision that all men, women and children in our community have the opportunity to attain self-sufficiency with dignity and are able to fulfill their potential; and

WHEREAS, People Helping People was founded in 1992 by several government officials who saw the need for a local non profit to supply emergency and short-term social services; and

WHEREAS, They offer various programs that provide a safety net for people and help them achieve independence: The Domestic and Child Abuse Prevention Program offers 24 hour, 7 days per week intervention, education, advocacy and support services; and

WHEREAS, Their goal is to break the cycle of violence and child abuse by supporting individuals and families that are at risk or are involved in family violence.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED AND RESOLVED that this Board of Supervisors declares PEOPLE HELPING PEOPLE OF SANTA YNEZ VALLEY, as the THIRD DISTRICT COMMISSION FOR WOMEN SERVICE AWARD RECIPIENT.
