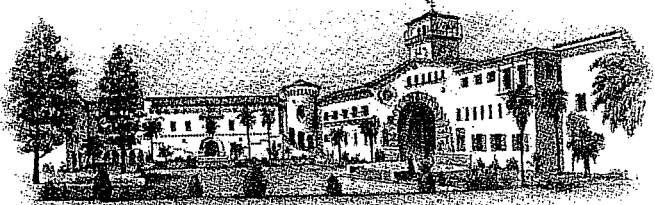

**RESOLUTION HONORING  
SAN MARCOS HIGH SCHOOL  
AND THE SANTA BARBARA SOCCER CLUB  
FOR THE COMPLETION OF THE  
FIELD OF CHAMPIONS FUNDRAISING EFFORT**

*WHEREAS, The San Marcos High School Field of Champions was a collaborative fundraising effort between the Santa Barbara Soccer Club and the San Marcos community and its Athletics Booster Club. This fundraising partnership was forged to achieve the common goals of enhancing the quality of the playing field used by young athletes and community groups; and*

*WHEREAS, the Field of Champions upgrades the Puailoa Field, named for former teacher, coach and Athletic Director for San Marcos High School Sut Puailoa, from a grass field to an Astroturf field ; and*

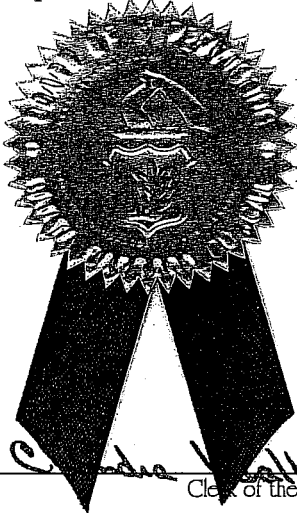
*WHEREAS, young athletes will benefit greatly from the replacement of the grass field with synthetic turf, a safe and more environmentally sound playing surface; and*

*WHEREAS, the Astroturf field will provide cost savings, reduced risk of injury, and reduction in use of fertilizers, pesticides, and water; and*

*WHEREAS, San Marcos High School's Valley Stadium is being renamed Warkentin Stadium in honor of the Warkentin family's significant donation to the Field of Champions.*

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that this Board of Supervisors honors and commends San Marcos High School and the Santa Barbara Soccer Club for their Field of Champions fundraising efforts.
