SUBJECT: Construction of 2001/2002 TEA-21 (RSTP) Misc. Concrete Repairs, Roadway Rehabilitation and Asphalt Concrete Overlay in the 2nd, 3rd, 4th and 5th Supervisorial Districts and the City of Goleta in Santa Barbara County, County Project No. 810479

Recommendation(s):

That the Board of Supervisors:

- A. Approve plans and specifications for the Construction of 2001/2002 TEA-21 (RSTP) Misc. Concrete Repairs, Roadway Rehabilitation and Asphalt Concrete Overlay in the 2nd, 3rd, 4th and 5th Supervisorial Districts and the City of Goleta in Santa Barbara County, County Project No. 810479;
- B. Award the construction contract in the amount of \$ 1,539,311.00 to the lowest responsible bidder, Granite Construction Company (Not a Local Vendor), P. O. Box 50085, Watsonville, California 95077-5085, subject to the provisions of documents and certification, as set forth in the plans and specifications applicable to the project, as required under California Law;
- C. Authorize chair to execute the construction contract upon return of the Contractor's executed contract documents, and the review and approval of the County Counsel, Auditor Controller and Risk Manager or their authorized representatives;
- D. Approve contingency fund in the amount of \$ 89,465.55 for the Construction of 2001/2002 TEA-21 (RSTP) Misc. Concrete Repairs, Roadway Rehabilitation and Asphalt Concrete Overlay in the 2nd, 3rd, 4th and 5th Supervisorial Districts and the City of Goleta in Santa Barbara County, County Project No. 810479.



Alignment with Board Strategic Plan:

The recommendation(s) are primarily aligned with Goal No. 1, An Efficient Government Able to Respond Effectively to the Needs of the Community.

Executive Summary and Discussion:

The project consists of concrete repair and surface treatment. The concrete repair includes the removal and replacement of damaged concrete curbs, gutters and sidewalks, and tree root pruning and shielding. Approximately 400 linear feet of curb & gutter and sidewalk will be repaired. The surface treatment includes the rehabilitation and asphalt concrete overlay of the existing roadways. This repair also includes removing and repairing failed areas in the existing pavement. Approximately 8.0 lane miles of County maintained roadway would be repaired and resurfaced with this project.

On Thursday, September 26, 2002, three (3) bids were opened for the Construction of 2001/2002 TEA-21 (RSTP) Misc. Concrete Repairs, Roadway Rehabilitation and Asphalt Concrete Overlay in the 2nd, 3rd, 4th and 5th Supervisorial Districts and the City of Goleta in Santa Barbara County, County Project No. 810479.

Construction of 2001/2002 TEA-21 (RSTP) Miscellaneous Concrete Repairs, Roadway Rehabilitation and Asphalt Concrete Overlay at Various Locations in Santa Barbara County, County Project No. 810479

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The lowest responsible bid was submitted by Granite Construction Company, in the amount of \$1,539,311.00, which is 3.85% below the Engineer's Estimate. Public Works staff has reviewed the bid and have found it to be reasonable.

The project was bid in accordance with the Public Contract Code, which requires the Department to award to the lowest responsible bidder.

The specific project locations were approved by the Board in the FY 2001/2002 Road Maintenance Annual Plan (RdMap).

This project was reviewed by the Capital Advisory Committee and Capital Improvement Committee and approved by your Board in the FY 2001/2002 Capital Improvement Plan.

Mandates and Service Levels:

No change in programs or service levels.

Fiscal and Facilities Impacts:

This project will be fully reimbursed by the Regional STP program, which is administered by SBCAG. Funding for this project is budgeted in Fund 0015, Program 2900, Org. Unit 0001, Department 054 and Account 7510.
