- C. Direct the District to have the staff report regarding the Annual Maintenance Plan available to interested parties on June 16, 2005.

ALIGNMENT WITH STRATEGIC PLAN:

The recommendations are primarily aligned with Goal No. 2. Ensure the Public Health and Safety and Provide Essential Infrastructure.

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY & DISCUSSION:

The Annual Maintenance Plan is being prepared to describe the routine maintenance of various creeks. Two public workshops are scheduled for June 1, 2005 (6:00 p.m. in Public Works Conference Room #1 in Santa Barbara), and June 2, 2005 (6:00 p.m. in Santa Maria at Betteravia Government Center, Board Conference Room). Staff will modify the projects as appropriate and a staff report detailing the projects will be prepared. Staff requests that a hearing be set for June 28, 2005 to consider the plan's approval. The Annual Maintenance Plan staff report will be available for public review and also distributed to your Board on June 16, 2005.

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MANDATES & SERVICE LEVELS:

The Annual Maintenance Plan contains addenda to the Program EIR for the District's routine maintenance program (01-EIR-01), which was approved by your Board on December 11, 2001. The Annual Maintenance Plan provides for maintenance of creeks, channels, and basins to preserve flood flow capacities throughout the County.

FACILITIES AND FISCAL IMPACT:

There are no fiscal impacts with this action. Upon approval of the Maintenance Plan, the associated work is funded out of the 10 Flood Zones in the County. This maintenance work is included in the proposed FY 2005/06 Budget under the Maintenance cost center of the Water Resources Division of the Public Works Department.
