WHEREAS, Early care and education professionals are invested in being responsive to the child care needs of families, as evidenced by their collaborations and professional development; and

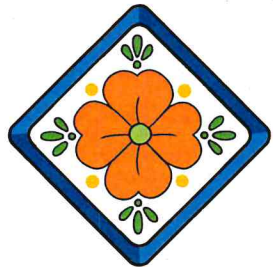
