- b) Adopt a Resolution approving the issuance by the Housing Authority of the County of Santa Barbara of its multifamily housing revenue obligations for the benefit of Perkins Place, L.P. in an aggregate principal amount not to exceed \$13,000,000.00, to finance the acquisition and construction of a 33-unit multifamily rental housing facility to be located in the unincorporated area of the County located at 60-70 Perkins Road, New Cuyama, California; and
- c) Determine that the above actions involve government funding mechanisms and/or fiscal activities and are not a project under the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA), pursuant to Section 15378(b)(4) of the CEQA Guidelines.
