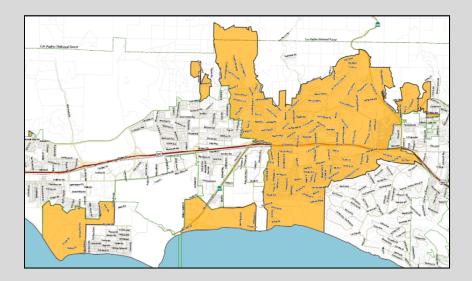

Goleta Valley CSA 3

- Created in 1963
- Streetlighting for unincorporated Goleta and Santa Barbara (18% of budget)
- Also funds open space and park maintenance
- Library services which is a separate Board action
- Proposed restoration of lighting benefit assessment from \$8 to \$24

Restoration of Street Lighting Benefit Assessment

Change from \$8 to \$24 per SFR

Adds \$133,232 to cover street lighting cost



- Allows for additional services
 - Median Maintenance \$50,000
 - Safety Tree Trimming \$20,000
 - Park Facility Improvements \$20,000
