### **Community Development Block Grant HOME Investment Partnerships Program**

#### **Introduction**

The United States Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) provides annual allocations of HOME Investment Partnership (HOME) program and Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) program funds to the County of Santa Barbara (County) HOME Consortium and CDBG Urban County Partnership, respectively. The County Community Services Department (CSD) is the lead entity for the HOME Consortium, which includes the unincorporated County and the cities of Buellton, Carpinteria, Goleta, Lompoc, Santa Maria, and Solvang, and for the CDBG Urban County, which includes the unincorporated County and the cities of Buellton, Carpinteria, and Solvang.

Each year, a draft Action Plan that contains the proposed uses of HOME and CDBG funds is made available to the public for input for a period of thirty (30) days prior to the public hearing in which the County Board of Supervisors (Board) awards the funds. Likewise, substantial amendments made to prior year Action Plans must undergo a public comment period and public hearing.

#### **Public Comment Period**

A public notice was published in local newspapers, on the County's website at [www.countyofsb.org/housing](http://www.countyofsb.org/housing), and at the offices of the County in Santa Barbara thirty (30) days prior to the scheduled Administrative Public Hearing. The notice described the proposed projects and where and how the draft substantial Action Plan amendment could be viewed, which included on the County's website at [www.countyofsb.org/housing](http://www.countyofsb.org/housing).

#### **Substantial Amendment to the FY 2021-2022 Action Plan CDBG Program**

The FY 2021-2022 Action Plan is being amended to allocate \$22,763 in previously unallocated CDBG Capital funds to the Santa Barbara Neighborhood Clinics' *Goleta Neighborhood Clinic Septic System Abandonment and Public Sewage Facility Connection Project*.

**Substantial Amendment to FY 2021-2022 HOME Investment Partnerships Program**

The 2021-22 Action Plan is being amended to award up to \$450,000 in HOME funds to the Housing Authority of the County of Santa Barbara (HASBARCO) for the Harry’s House senior affordable housing project (Project). The Project will provide sixty (60) units of rental housing, of which 59 units will house very-low income seniors and one unit will be occupied by an on-site manager. The Project will be located at 890 N. Refugio Road in Santa Ynez, California.
