Recommended Actions:

That the Board of Supervisors accept and file the Certified Statement of the Results of the Official Canvass and Official Election Summary for the General Election held on November 8, 2022, and declare those persons elected and declare the results as required by law.

Summary Text:

California Elections Code Section 15372 provides that the elections official shall prepare a certified statement of the results of the General Election held on November 8, 2022 and submit it to the governing body within 30 days of the election.

The Clerk-Recorder-Assessor, in his capacity as ex-officio Registrar of Voters, sent the certified statement to the Board of Supervisors on December 7, 2022 and request that the board declare elected those persons pursuant to the Statement of Votes Cast Election Summary Report as required by law.

California Elections Code Section 15620 allows any voter, within five days, but not later than 5:00 p.m. on the fifth day, following the completion of the canvass, to file a request for a recount with the county elections official of the votes cast for candidates for any office that is not voted on statewide. The "completion of the canvass" shall be presumed to be that time when the elections official signs the certified statement of the results of the election. As the signing of the certified statement occurred on December 7, 2022, the written request for a recount must be filed with the county elections official no

later than 5:00 pm on Monday, December 12, 2022. The deadline for filing a written request for a recount has been posted on our website along with the certified results.
