SUBJECT: Construction of Cable Mesh Drapery System for Storm Damage Repair, on Gibraltar Road and Gobernador Canyon Road located in the First Supervisorial District of Santa Barbara County.
Santa Barbara County Project No. 05STRM – 1T47 and 1T53.

Recommendation(s):

That the Board of Supervisors:

- A. Accept Notice of Completion for work performed by the Contractor, A.I.S. Construction Company, (not a local vendor), Post Office Box 24620, Ventura, California, 93002, and authorize Clerk to record.
- B. Review and approve the Statement of Final Quantities for work performed and materials supplied for this project by the Contractor, in the amount of \$295,020.84

Alignment with Board Strategic Plan:

The recommendations are primarily aligned with Goal No. 1, An Efficient Government Able to Anticipate and Respond Effectively to the Needs of the Community.

Executive Summary and Discussion:

This project was constructed to mitigate against future erosion of the slope and reduce the energy of dislodged boulders and materials from the overly steep hillside. The project consisted of the installation of a cable mesh drapery system along the exposed slope to reduce the danger of additional rockfall on the traveling public and nearby residents.

The Director of Public Works accepted this project as complete on January 24, 2006. The project was completed on time and on budget.

Fiscal and Facilities Impacts:

The Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) has provided 75% of the funding for this project, and the State Office of Emergency Services (OES) provided 18.75% of the funding. The remaining cost was provided from Measure D funds. .

Funds were budgeted in Department 054, Fund 0015, Program 2900, Org Unit 0002, Account 7510 (FEMA and OES), and Account 7511 (Measure D).
