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**Recommendation(s):**

Set for a public hearing on March 6, 2001, in Santa Barbara, with a 10-day notice, the adoption of the attached resolution proclaiming the Canby House, located in Santa Barbara, California (A.P.N. 007-120-040), as an historical landmark.

**Executive Summary and Discussion:**

The property and structures currently known as the Canby House, were granted historical merit status on September 11, 2000, by the Historical Landmark Advisory Commission (HLAC) at its regularly scheduled monthly meetings. A motion to recommend that the Board of Supervisors proclaim the Canby House as an historical landmark was passed by the Commission on January 8, 2001 at its regularly scheduled monthly meeting.
