Set a hearing to consider the Bedford Appeal (Case #08APL-00000-00034) of the County Planning Commission's approval of the Lompoc Wind Energy Project (Case # 06CUP-00000-00009) for December 16, 2008.

Summary Text:

George and Cheryl Bedford filed an appeal of the Planning Commission's September 30, 2008 approval of the Lompoc Wind Energy Project. The appeal contends that the approved project does not conform to the applicable General Plan policies, the applicable zoning ordinances, and has not complied with the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA). The project approval and all specific conditions therewith, are being appealed. County Counsel has invited the parties to participate in a facilitation process.
