WHEREAS, Guillaume Doane has worked as a reporter and editor of the Montecito Journal since June 1, 2004, during which time he assigned and edited nearly 2,000 articles and personally wrote over 500; and

WHEREAS, Guillaume has reported on a broad spectrum of community topics, such as history, politics, social events, wine, food, humor, finance, travel, and the Montecito lifestyle; and he provided in-depth coverage of water rate increases, the Coral Casino remodel, the Westmont campus expansion, the Montecito Planning Commission, Montecito's special districts, the Montecito Association, County government, local schools and public works projects; and

WHEREAS, during Guillaume's tenure as editor, the Journal become a weekly newspaper, added a website, redesigned its printed pages, and added several easy-to-keep pullout sections including, "The ABC's of Back-to-School," "Montecito's Public Affairs Directory" and "The State of Montecito—A Five Year Review" all of which have increased the Journal's readership and ability to report local news in a timely and efficient manner; and

WHEREAS, Guillaume generously supported non-profits in our community by providing space, photographs and front-page covers in the Journal for numerous philanthropic causes, including the Montecito Union School Carnival, Montecito Association Beautification Day and Village Fourth, Music Academy May Madness, Cold Spring School flagship fundraiser, Lotusland and Crane School.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDERED AND RESOLVED, that this Board of Supervisors honors and commends Guillaume Doane for his dedication to the profession of journalism and for keeping our community well informed on events of local importance.
