WHEREAS, Sandra focused her work at the Public Health Department on mothers and children at high risk of poor outcomes through the Teenage Pregnancy Prevention Program (TAPP), Multi-agency Integrated System of Care (MISC), Child Health & Disability Program (CHDP), Healthcare for the Homeless (HCH) and Maternal Child Adolescent Health (MCAH) programs demonstrating skills in both providing compassionate nursing services and in managing others to achieve success and positive outcomes; and

WHEREAS, Sandra excelled in working collaboratively with community partners throughout the County such as the Perinatal Wellness Coalition, First Five and the Oral Health Executive Committee, recognizing that together we are stronger and better at meeting the needs of our residents; and
