Consider recommendations regarding an amendment of the 401(h) Plan and Change to Eligibility for Retiree Medical Subsidies, as follows:

- b) Adopt a Resolution In the Matter of Amending the Personnel Benefits Policy for Management and Confidential-Unrepresented Employees to eliminate retiree medical subsidies prospectively for unrepresented safety managers; and
