WHEREAS, from 1999 to 2006 Susan served on the Santa Barbara County Board of Supervisors where she developed initiatives for affordable housing, homelessness, and environmental health; and

WHEREAS, currently, Susan is vice-chair of the Santa Barbara Human Rights Watch Committee and member of the international Advisory Board of the Women's Rights Division; and

WHEREAS, Susan has worked in many capacities to mentor young women in government, politics, and community service. She cofounded the Santa Barbara Women's Political Committee, an organization dedicated to helping women achieve elected and appointed office; and

WHEREAS, in 2010 California Women Lead inducted Susan into their hall of fame.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that this Board of Supervisors honors and commends Susan Rose for her outstanding contributions to our community and for being a recipient of the 2012 Anti-Defamation League Distinguished Community Service Award.
