We are requesting 60 USAR, “Urban Search and Rescue” backpacks manufactured by 5.11 “Rush 72 hour 55 Liter backpack”, with a top of the line EXFIL SAR TACTICAL HELMET AND ATTACHED Princeton TEC headlamp. Also included in this package would be two separate field guides. These field guides are made by US Army Core of Engineers and titled “USAR Field Operations Guide Edition 8.2.” This guide assists with Shoring up structures in disaster zones.

This purchase would allow the member to have top-notch safety gear and a way to keep it organized and secure.

No Program Support for Required Equipment:

Program Support is not available for any material or equipment that is required by Federal, State or Local authority. If the equipment is required by law to be available for the individual firefighter, vehicle, helicopter, etc., it is not an eligible expense for consideration.

We Pay the Manufacturer/Vendor Directly:

Payment for equipment purchases can only be made to the manufacturer or vendor. We will not write reimbursement checks to Santa Barbara City Fire, The City of Santa Barbara, Santa Barbara County Fire or the County of Santa Barbara.

The Recipient Agency is Responsible for Maintenance of the Equipment:

Once the equipment is purchased and donated to the recipient agency, that agency is responsible for all costs associated with the parts, supplies and maintenance required to keep the donated equipment in working order.

Equipment Must be Purchased Within 6 Months of Board Approval Date:

Equipment approved for purchase must be ordered within 6 months of Board approval date. This can be extended by Board review and approval. Any monies approved by the Board which are not spent within 6 months will revert back to the SBFA General Appropriations Fund and be "Available for Appropriation" to future City Fire or County Fire funding requests. Any unspent funds will not be held specifically available for the agency originally granted the fund request unless an exception is requested and approved in advance by the SBFA Board of Directors.

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1. What are you requesting? Describe equipment or program support. Include brochures or photographs.

HS-4 Hot Shield Face Mask with Sundstrom SR-100 Half Face Respirator. The Hot Shield face mask provides thermal protection for face and neck while the respirator provides lung protection with a P100 filter as well as chemical gas filters. Cartridges are replaceable. Respirator will provide a tight seal unlike one time use n-95 masks. The equipment comes packaged as a Hot Shield Wildland kit which includes Hot Shield face mask, Sundstrom SR100 Respirator, P100/HEPA filter, 5 pre-filters, Spark Arrestor and carrying pouch. Each safety member and hand-crew member will be outfitted with a Hot Shield Wildland Kit.

2. What is the expected cost? Submit detailed quote from the proposed vendor as an attachment to this form. Please include vendor name, phone number, address, email address, and web site.

Cost to outfit the entire Department and Hand Crew with everyone having their own personal respirator would be \$49,106.65. This includes 260 Hs-4 Hot Shield Wildland kits, 300 extra P100 particulate filters, 280 chemical filters, and 1600 extra pre-filters.

3. Who will use the equipment or program support?

Every Santa Barbara County Fire Department Safety member and Hand Crew member will be assigned their own respiratory protection device Hot Shield Wildland Kit for use on Wildland, Urban Interface, and structure defense fires.

4. Who in our community will be served by this program support?

Everyone who lives in and around the wildland environment throughout the state of California. When rescuers are able to breathe without choking on smoke and particulates they are able to think clearly during emergency operations and improve tactical decision capability. The respirator protects members from respiratory injuries which cause short term to long term injuries. Keeping our members healthy and safe will benefit the community.

5. Why are you requesting this equipment/program through the Alliance rather than your Agency?

The 2017 California fire season included five of the 20 most destructive wildland-urban interface fires in the state's history. The fires destroyed or damaged more than 10,000 structures in the state (destroyed 9,470, damaged 810), a higher tally than the previous nine years combined. The 2018 fire season has just surpassed the structure loss of the record high from 2017. The gases found in vegetation and structure fires are known to kill.

Our rescuers are in desperate need of lung and airway protection when our SCBAs are unable to be used. The respirator provides excellent inhalation protection as an alternate respiratory protection device, "ARD".

The 2017-2018 fire season produce multiple inhalation injuries such as chemical induced bronchitis to valley fever. This year SBC members trialed this new equipment with a "We need this" approval rating.

Unfortunately it was in the middle of the budget year so it was denied.

6. How long will the equipment or program support likely be in service?


5-10 years depending on the fire seasons.

7. Is ongoing maintenance for the equipment/program required? If so what are the anticipated costs for maintenance/replacement.

Depending on new hires and a busy annual fire seasons replacing cartridges would be approximately \$3500 a year. The current Hot Shield and antiquated N95 mask will be replaced by the state of the art HS-4 Hot Shield Face Mask with Sundstrom SR-100 Half Face Respirator.




