The Role of Public Health

CalAIM: offering a No Wrong Door approach

- “ a plan of integrating Medi-Cal with other social services to improve outcomes for the millions of Californians covered by Medi-Cal, especially those with the most complex needs”.
- Focus on:
 - People with significant behavioral health needs
 - Seniors and people living with disabilities
 - People experiencing homelessness who also have complex physical and behavioral needs
 - People transitioning from jail or juvenile justice centers who also have complex physical and behavioral needs
 - Children with complex medical conditions
 - Children and youth in foster care

CalAIM in the Justice Involved (JI): Pre-release Services

- Offering health services up to 90 days before release:
 - Health Screenings, Risk Assessments and Appropriate Treatment
 - Laboratory and Radiology Services
 - Physical and Behavioral Health Consultations
 - Warm Handoffs for Case Management
- Establishing a plan for community based care
 - Reentry Care Plan
 - Care Coordination
 - Linkages & Referrals
 - Release Planning
- Billing and Oversight
 - *Medi-Cal Billing*
 - *Monitoring, Oversights, and Reporting*



Role of PHD – CalAIM Implementation


- PHD will lend expertise in implementing CalAIM.
- PHD will provide clinical oversight of screenings, health assessments and clinical consultations conducted by health provider.
- PHD will oversee care management and coordination of care for eligible JI.
- PHD will implement and manage an Electronic Health Record that is capable of billing.
- PHD will provide oversight, monitoring and reporting of all CalAIM activities in JI as required by the State.



Role of PHD – CalAIM Billing

- PHD is will oversee the day to day billing operations and communications between County and third party Medi-Cal biller for in custody health services.
- PHD will work with health provider and County partners to ensure service providers are submitting their coded services in a timely manner to the 3rd Party Billing Company.
- PHD will continuously monitor and audit claims and will provide targeted training if a trend of denials is identified.
