RESOLUTION HONORING THE CITY OF LOMPOC ON ITS 135th ANNIVERSARY OF INCORPORATION

WHEREAS, the City of Lompoc is surrounded by beautiful rolling hills in Santa Barbara County, California, and has a rich history that dates back thousands of years to when it was first inhabited by the native Chumash, who have continuously resided in the area for at least 10,000 years; and

WHEREAS, the origin of Lompoc's name derives from the Chumash, with various translations that reference lakes, lagoons, estuaries or where the land meets the sea; and

WHEREAS, in 1874 the Lompoc Land Company was formed, paving the way to incorporation of the City of Lompoc on August 13, 1888, as a California general law city; and

WHEREAS, throughout its history, Lompoc has flourished with innovation from various industries including: agriculture, flower and flower seed production, mining of diatomaceous earth, space technology, tourism, viticulture, and the arts; and

WHEREAS, Lompoc has been a major contributor to space technology, with the establishment of neighboring Vandenberg Air Force Base (now Vandenberg Space Force Base) in 1958, and is now a premier global launch facility; and

WHEREAS, the City of Lompoc, a full service, business friendly city, has continuously evolved with the times and currently enjoys the status of being a wine, and arts & culture destination, attractive to residents and visitors alike!

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED AND RESOLVED that the Board of Supervisors of Santa Barbara County does hereby honor the City of Lompoc for its significant contributions to the County, our nation, and the world for the past 135 years.
