That the Board of Supervisors:

Authorize the Director of Public Works Dept. to advertise for the Reconstruction of the Construction & Demolition (C&D) Pad for the Foxen Canyon Transfer Station.


### Alignment with Board Strategic Plan:

The recommendations are primarily aligned with Goal No. 2. Ensure the public health and safety and provide essential infrastructure for the Tajiguas Landfill.

#### **Executive Summary and Discussion:**

The Solid Waste & Utilities Division (SWUD) is proposing to reconstruct the C&D Pad for the Foxen Canyon Transfer Station. The existing C&D Pad needs to be reconstructed with a concrete slab surface and low retaining wall along two sides. This project is required in connection with current operations and the conversion of Foxen Canyon Landfill to a Transfer Station when Foxen Canyon closes. It is anticipated that the project will go to bid during April 2002 and that construction will commence during July or August 2002.

The reconstruction of the C&D Pad for Foxen Canyon Landfill was reviewed in compliance with CEQA under the first supplemental EIR #97-SD-02 (The Santa Ynez Valley Waste Management Plan).



### **Mandates and Service Levels:**

There will be no change in level of service.

## **Fiscal and Facilities Impacts:**

This project is funded by the Solid Waste Enterprise Fund Tipping Fees, Dept. 054, Fund 1930, Acct. 7460. Cost of the project is estimated at \$120,000.
