RESOLUTION PROCLAIMING

NATIONAL INFANT IMMUNIZATION WEEK
AND THE MONTH OF MAY 2008
TODDLER IMMUNIZATION MONTH

WHEREAS, diseases such as polio, measles and chickenpox, prevalent in this country 50 years ago, are rarely seen today thanks to vaccines; and

WHEREAS, many vaccine-preventable diseases, prevalent in other parts of the world, remain just a plane ride away; and

WHEREAS, parents and guardians need to protect children's health by ensuring timely receipt of all childhood vaccines; and

WHEREAS, efforts are needed to continue awareness about childhood vaccines that will protect California children against serious diseases;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT AND IT IS HEREBY ORDERED AND RESOLVED that the Board of Supervisors of County of Santa Barbara does hereby proclaim the week of April 19-26, 2008 as National Infant Immunization Week and the month of May 2008 as Toddler Immunization Month.
