- b.) Review and approve the Statement of Final Quantities for work performed and materials supplied for this project by the Contractor in the amount of \$241,941.86.

Summary Text:

The project consisted of constructing a cable mesh drapery system (108 Ft in length) 3.5 Miles southeast of State Highway 154 along Stagecoach Road. The cable mesh drapery system installed provides rockfall protection to reduce road closure time during a weather event. Rain-fall events may induce rockfall movement. This cable mesh draping system will lessen the impact to the traveling public on Stagecoach Road if such an event would occur.

The Director of Public Works accepted this project as complete on February 10, 2009. The project was completed on time and under budget.

Stagecoach Road Storm Damage Repairs, Cable Mesh Drapery System 3.5 Miles Southeast of State Highway 154, 3rd Supervisorial District – County Project No. 862266

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Background:

The Stagecoach Road Storm Damage Repair Project is located on Stagecoach Road, approximately 3.5 miles southeast of State Highway 154, near the City of Santa Barbara. During the initial series of storms of January 2005, a large rockfall event occurred at the project location. The landslide forced the closure of the road for a period of 4-5 days for public safety reasons until County-directed Contractors could be mobilized to begin debris removal activities and dressing up of the site.

In order to mitigate against further destabilization at this site and minimize the potential impacts to the traveling public, a cable mesh drapery system was extended (108ft in length) along Stagecoach Road. The installation of rockfall protection is designed to reduce road closure time during a future storm or earthquake induced rockfall movement, and lessens the likelihood of direct impact of rockfall on users of Stagecoach Road. This occurs by reducing the energy of the rock fall and by containment of the majority of falling rock and earthen debris. The Department has installed this system adjacent to this location and elsewhere on the south coast and has seen the benefits of its installation.
