SUBJECT: Construction of Storm Damage Repair on Ballard Canyon Road at M.P. 2.49; Third Supervisorial District; County Project No. 98R054

Recommendation(s):

That the Board of Supervisors:

Review and approve the Statement of Final Quantities for work performed and materials supplied for this project by the Contractor, Specialty Construction Company (not a local vendor), 202 Tank Farm Road, San Luis Obispo CA, in the amount of \$217,413.65.

Alignment with Board Strategic Plan:

The recommendation is primarily aligned with Goal No. 1, An Efficient Government Able to Anticipate and Respond Effective to the Needs of the Community.

Executive Summary and Discussion:

This project consisted of reconstructing the roadway to its original width, and replacement of the culvert with a 14-foot by 9-foot 8-inch structural steel plate arch culvert. The new culvert's headwalls consist of driven steel sheet piling. Pipe and tire revetment was installed to protect the creek banks downstream of the road.

The heavy winter storms of 1998 caused extensive damage to the existing 84-inch corrugated steel pipe, headwall, outlet structure, and a 100-foot segment of Ballard Canyon Road. The roadway damage included embankment erosion and loss of traveled way.

The contract was accepted on July 1, 2002, by the Director of Public Works as complete.

This project was completed on time and under the budgeted contract amount.
