Recommended Actions:

- A. That the County of Santa Barbara Board of Supervisors (Board of Supervisors) set September 11, 2007, as the date for public hearing for the Board of Supervisors to consider and approve the attached proposed amendments to the Conflict of Interests Code ("Code") of the Los Alamos Community Services ("District").
- B. That the Board of Supervisors on September 11, 2007, approve the amendments to the District's Code.

Summary Text:

On July 22, 2007, county counsel received the attached amendments to the Code that the District approved on May 23, 2007, that revises (1) the District's Code by incorporating by reference as its Code the model conflict of interests code promulgated by the Fair Political Practices Commission; (2) the designated positions that are required by the Code to disclose economic interest; and (3) the financial interests disclosure categories for such designated positions.

Background:

All public agencies are required by the Political Reform Act of 1974 (Act) to:

1. Adopt local conflict of interests codes that identify those agency employee positions (designated positions) that are subject to the conflict of interest codes; and
2. Review the need for any revisions to the code on a biannual basis.

The District conducted such a biannual review and adopted the proposed amendments to its Code following such review.

The revised Code is effective on its approval by the Board of Supervisors.
