## Group No. 1. \$88.00 for any or all of the following:

- 1. Flammable liquids in excess of five gallons in a building or excess of ten gallons outside of any building;
- 2. Combustible liquids in excess of 25 gallons in a building;
- 3. Cryogenic fluids, including flammables, oxidizers or corrosives (including oxygen), in excess of one gallon in a building; or
- 4. Organic peroxides in excess of ten pounds.

  Group 1 does not include fuel systems of vehicles or fuel used in connection with oil-burning equipment.

### Group No. 2. \$175.00 for any or all of the following:

- 1. Any quantity of explosives, water reactive, pyrophoric or hypergolic materials, highly toxic poisons, radioactive materials or disease-causing agents:
- 2. 200 cubic feet or more but less than 2,000 cubic feet at standard temperature and pressure for compressed gas;
- 3. 55 gallons or more but less than 550 gallons; or
- 4. 500 pounds or more but less than 5,000 pounds.

### Group No. 3. \$219.00 for any or all of the following:

- 1. 2,000 cubic feet or more but less than 10,000 cubic feet at standard temperature and pressure for compressed gas;
- 2. 550 gallons or more but less than 2,700 gallons; or
- 3. 5,000 pounds or more but less than 25,000 pounds.

### Group No. 4. \$263.00 for any or all of the following:

- 1. 10,000 cubic feet or more at standard temperature or pressure for compressed gas;
- 2, 2,700 gallons or more; or
- 3. 25,000 pounds or more.
