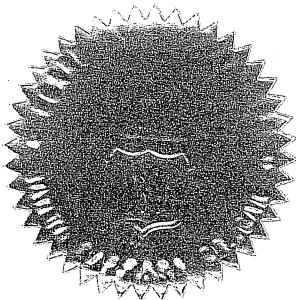
WHEREAS, it is fitting and proper to protect the freedoms set forth in the Bill of Rights; and
