RESOLUTION RECOGNIZING NOVEMBER 14th, 2024 AS COMMUNIFY DAY IN SANTA BARBARA COUNTY

WHEREAS, CommUnify embraces the values of equity and inclusion, ensuring that every individual is treated with dignity and respect, regardless of their background or circumstances; and

WHEREAS, since its founding, CommUnify has expanded vital services to reach the most vulnerable members of our community, opening multiple locations across the county to meet local needs; and

WHEREAS, CommUnify provides essential programs for all ages, including prenatal care, early childhood education, medical and mental health screenings, behavioral health services, youth mentoring, job assistance, rental aid, home energy support, weatherization services, and senior safety programs; and

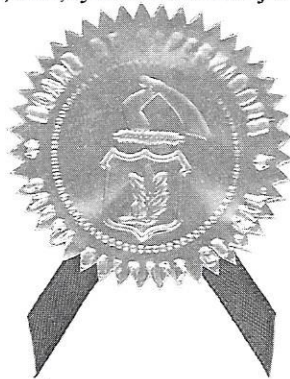
WHEREAS, CommUnify has impacted countless lives by combating poverty and fostering upward mobility across the county; and
