Project Title: Fifth Amendment to License and Service Agreement for Safe Overnight Parking Program


Project Description: The proposed action is for the renewal of a license and service agreement for the continued use of designated parking spaces in County-owned parking lots for New Beginnings Counseling Center's Safe Overnight Parking Program and does not involve an expansion of use.

Reasons to support exemption findings: The proposed action is for the renewal of a license and service agreement for the continued use of designated parking spaces in County-owned parking lots for New Beginnings Counseling Center's Safe Overnight Parking Program and does not involve an expansion of use and is therefore categorically exempt from CEQA as stated in CEQA Guidelines Section 15301: Class 1 consists of the operation, repair and maintenance, permitting, leasing, licensing, or minor alteration of existing public or private structures, facilities, mechanical equipment, or topographical features, involving negligible or no expansion of use.
