That the Board of Supervisors accept and file the Certification of Results for the Statewide Direct Primary Election held on June 3, 2014, as required by law.

Summary:

The results of the June 3, 2014 Statewide Direct Primary Election were certified on June 16, 2014. Elections Code § 15372 requires the Registrar of Voters to prepare a certified statement of the results of the election and submit it to the governing body within 28 days of the election. An official Certificate of Election Results of the Official Canvass (Attachment A) and an Official Election Summary are attached (Attachment B). The Statement of Votes Cast by precinct for the election is available on the Clerk, Recorder and Assessor & Registrar of Voters website at www.sbcvote.com.

Election Code § 15400 requires that the governing body declare elected to each office voted on at the election the person having the highest number of votes for that office or who was elected or nominated under the exceptions noted in Section 15452. The governing board shall also declare the results of the election for each measure under its jurisdiction.

Elections Code § 15620 allows any voter, within five days of the certification date, to file a request for recount with the county elections official of the votes cast candidates for any office, or any measure provided that the office or measure is not voted on statewide. The request must be filed no later than Monday, June 23, 2014.

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Elections Code § 15621 allows any voter within five days beginning the 29th day after a statewide election to file with the Secretary of State a request for a recount of votes cast for candidates for any statewide office or any proposition voted on statewide.
