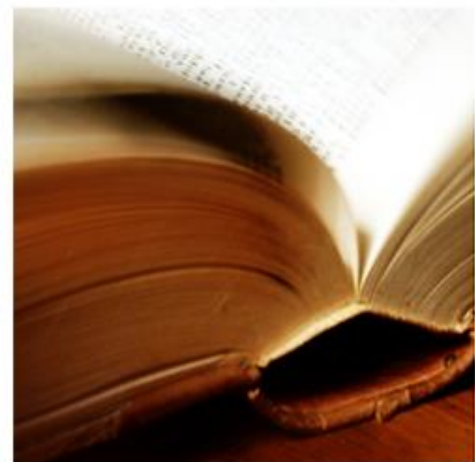


Senate Bill 277

Vaccinations

March 24, 2015



SB 277 Summary

- Legislative Committee had a positive recommendation
- Proposed law would eliminate vaccination exemptions of students based on personal belief
- Would only allow for medical exemptions
- Impact all children who attend public and private child care, elementary and secondary school
- Less than 95% of student body is vaccinated, community protected when rate is closer to 100%

Recommended Actions

Option 1:

- A. Take an advocacy position of support, watch, or oppose on SB 277 (Pan) – Public Health: Vaccinations; and
- B. Direct staff to forward, and authorize the Chair to sign a letter stating the Board's decision to the legislative author, members of the legislature including, but not limited to, the county legislative delegation, and appropriate committee chairs; and

Option 2:

- A. Take no position on SB 277 (Pan) – Public Health: Vaccinations
