SUBJECT:	Solid Waste Tipping Fees, Collection Rates and Parcel Fees for Fiscal Year 2004/2005 All Supervisorial Districts

#### **Recommendation(s):**

That the Board of Supervisors:

- 1. Set a Public Hearing for June 1, 2004 for 30 minutes to consider increases in solid waste disposal and collection fees.
- 2. Following Staff presentation, adopt resolution (Exhibit 1) setting the fee schedules for:
  - a. Solid waste handling and disposal fees at County facilities, per Attachment A, effective July 1, 2004, and
  - b. Solid waste collection rates in the unincorporated area and the City of Goleta, per Attachment B, effective July 1, 2004.
- 3. Adopt resolution (Exhibit 2) setting the Parcel Fee Schedule for the Cuyama Valley for Fiscal Year 2004/2005, effective July 1, 2004.
- 4. Accept the Public Works Department's Notice of Exemption pursuant to the County's California Environmental Quality Act Guidelines (Exhibit 3);

#### **Executive Summary and Discussion:**

Each year your Board adopts solid waste disposal and collection fees in accordance with Chapter 17 of the Santa Barbara County Code. Current franchise agreements with the solid waste collectors require the County to increase the collection portion of the rates each year by specified percentages of the Consumer Price Index (CPI) as well as incorporate any increases in tipping or handling fees associated with the material collected by the service providers.

#### **Disposal Fees**

The Public Works Department is proposing a \$3.00 per ton increase to its tipping fee, from the current \$48.00 per ton to \$51.00 per ton for trash accepted at the Tajiguas Landfill and the Santa Ynez Valley Recycling and Transfer Station (SYVRTS - formerly the Foxen Canyon Landfill), and from \$67.00 per ton to \$70.00 per ton at the South Coast Recycling and Transfer Station (SCRTS). The impact of this increase to an average residential ratepayer will be \$0.22 per month or \$2.64 per year. The impact to an average commercial account will be \$1.73 per month or \$20.76 per year. In comparison, the City of Lompoc has implemented a two-stage increase to its tipping fee from \$60.00 per ton to \$64.10 per ton. The first increase of \$2.10 per ton was implemented on November 7, 2003, and the remaining \$2.00 per ton will go into effect on July 1, 2004. Lompoc Valley customers will be affected by these tipping fee increases. The City of Santa Maria will not be increasing their tipping fee, however, the fee is currently \$69.89 per ton, which affects Orcutt customers.

In addition, increases are being proposed for the minimum load charges for trash, clean construction and demolition (C&D) material, and non-CRT (Cathode Ray Tube) electronic waste brought to County facilities. Finally, staff proposes an increase in delivery fees for mulch produced from greenwaste and a new flat loading fee for loading mulch at the SCRTS. All these proposed increases are summarized in Attachment A.

#### Collection Rates

Annually, your Board sets the rates charged by the solid waste collectors to residential and commercial customers in the unincorporated area and the City of Goleta. FY 2004/05 rates will be affected by the annual CPI to the service providers and the increases in tipping fees. The CPI that was used to adjust the rates this fiscal year is 1.9% and was calculated using the U.S. Department of Labor Los Angeles-Riverside CPI from February 2003 to February 2004. This CPI adjustment is only made on the portion of the rate that reimburses the haulers for the collection of waste materials.

Proposed residential and commercial rates are shown on Attachment B. The following table provides an example of the monthly rate increases for residential customers using a standard service level consisting of 60 gallons of trash and/or green waste service and up to 90 gallons of recyclables collected for each zone.

The following table provides an example of the proposed monthly rate increases using a 2 cubic yard commercial container serviced once per week in the different service areas. Again, the percent increase also includes the CPI increase on the collection portion of the rate.

#### Cuyama Valley Parcel Fees

Finally, the Cuyama Valley is served by two County operated transfer stations built in 1996, which replaced the local landfills upon their closure. MarBorg Industries is contracted by the County to transport waste from the transfer stations to the Tajiguas Landfill. MarBorg Industries also provides solid waste collection service to a small number of residents and businesses in the Cuyama Valley. In accordance with Section 25830 of the California Government Code, property owners in the Cuyama Valley pay for solid waste disposal services through parcel fees according to a schedule that was established with the adoption of a

resolution by the Board of Supervisors in 1982 (Resolution Number 82-360). The fee schedule was established to generate revenue to offset the operation and maintenance costs for solid waste disposal services in Cuyama Valley.

The Public Works Department annually reviews these fees for adequacy and cost competitiveness. The Department is proposing no increase in rates for 2004/2005. The single-family occupied dwelling rate will be \$77.00 for the year. Other fees are based on a waste generation factor, established in 1982, comparing the single family dwelling rate to that of waste generated by other land uses. The Public Works Department requests that the Treasurer-Tax Collector continue to bill and collect the current fee as part of the regular County property tax system.

The proposed fee schedule for Cuyama Valley will generate approximately \$31,444 in revenue from the 594 parcels in the district. However, this amount does not cover the cost of service for Cuyama Valley residents, which is currently estimated at \$160,600. The unreimbursed cost is covered through North County program fees.

#### Mandates and Service Levels:

There will be no changes in service levels.

#### **Fiscal and Facilities Impacts:**

Tipping fees & collection rates are being increased consistent with consumer price index.

**RESOLUTION NO.** 

WHEREAS, the County of Santa Barbara operates and maintains waste collection sites in the Cuyama Valley, near New Cuyama and Ventucopa, and no fees are collected from the users of these sites, and

WHEREAS, Section 25830 of the Government Code permits the Board of Supervisors to establish a schedule of fees based upon the various uses to which the land is put, the volume of waste occurring from the different land uses, and many other factors that reasonably relate to the waste disposal fee, and to collect such fees by the County Tax Collector as part of the regular County Tax Billing System.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED AND RESOLVED that the land within County Assessor's Tax Code Areas 63-001 and 63-007 is served by the transfer stations in the New Cuyama Valley.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that a basic fee of \$77.00 per single-family dwelling with full-time occupancy reasonably relates to the benefit received by such land from the availability of solid waste collection sites within the Cuyama Valley, and such fee is hereby set for raising revenue necessary to partially finance the acquisition, operation and maintenance of the County Solid Waste Disposal Program.
