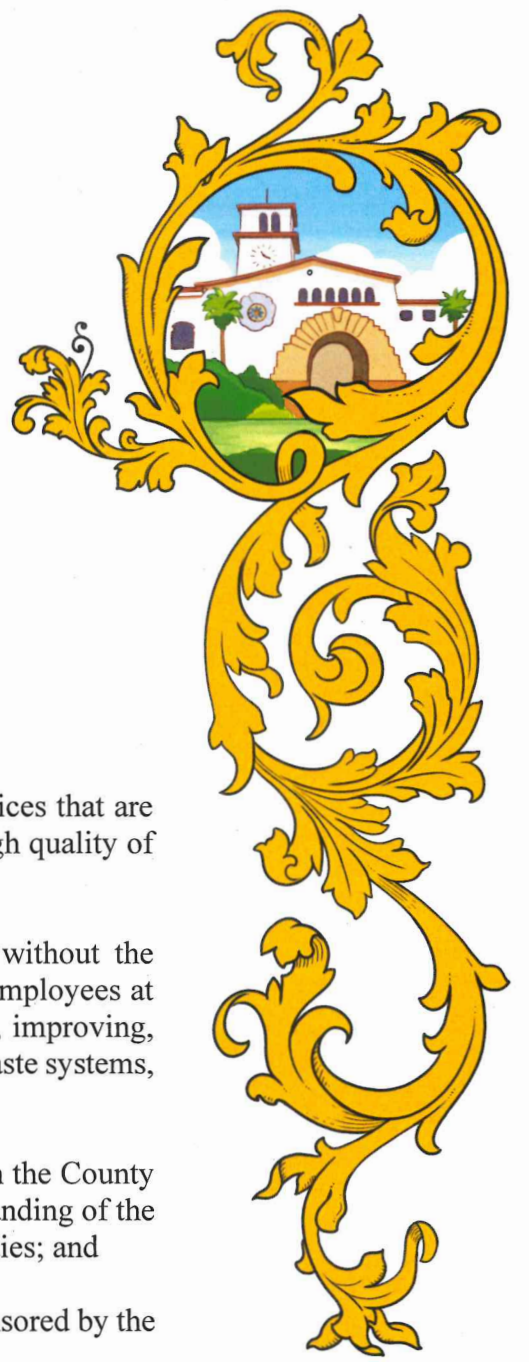

**RESOLUTION PROCLAIMING**  
**MAY 17 – 23, 2026 AS**  
**NATIONAL PUBLIC WORKS WEEK**
