WHEREAS, throughout her career at the County, Ms. Mendoza has always been recognized for her kindness, sense of humor, and her famous artichoke dip; and

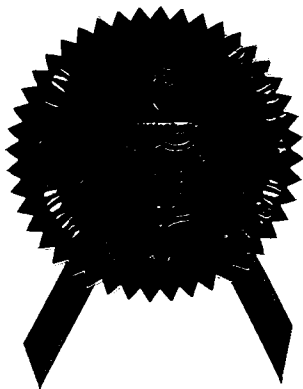
WHEREAS, Elena's commitment to her job and to her family, all the time with a smile on her face, serve as a role model for the rest of us to emulate; and
